


Figure 13 The threshold (Locus 108) of the doorway of the Crusader tower/Room 18.




Figure 30 The staircase that lead from the main courtyard to Room/courtyard 55.



Plan 1 The manor house, ground floor (general plan).




The manor house, second floor (general plan).




Plan 3 The excavation areas at the northwestern part of the manor house, ground floor.






Section B-B The doorway of Room 18.




Section C-C Room 18, looking west, with reconstructed line of staircase.






