

Dear Reviewer,

Thank you for accepting our invitation to write a book review for the *CALICO Journal*. We ask that you submit your book review **within eight weeks** of receiving your review copy. Below is information to guide you in the writing and uploading of your review.

Reviewer Guidelines

- Reviews should be double-spaced and 1,500 words all inclusive.
- Reviews should be written in English even when the book under review is in another language.
- References should adhere to the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, 6th ed. (2009).
- You are encouraged to look at past published reviews for an idea of the overall format and flow.
- Except for the title page book reviews should be in the same format as articles. The title page should take the following form:

Aspects of Japanese Women's Language. Edited by Sachiko Ide, and Naomi Hanaoka McGloin. Tokyo: Kuroshio Shuppan, 1990. Pp. 163. ISBN 4874240445. US \$ 90. Reviewed by (name, university, email).

- In addition to an overview of the book and the different chapters (in the case of edited volumes), book reviews should include a critical discussion that explores the publication's contribution to the field (e.g., CALL or applied linguistics), who its ideal readership is, noteworthy contributions, and omissions. The critical discussion should comprise approximately 2/3 of the review.
- In the case of larger volumes which contain many chapters, it is sufficient to highlight only key chapters for the purpose of providing critical discussion instead of simply summary.

Submitting Your Review

We accept only electronic submissions through the Online Journal System (ENTER NEW SUBMISSION). Before you can begin your first submission you must complete the following steps:

- Go to <http://www.equinoxpub.com/CALICO> and register with the system as an author and keep the automated e-mail with your user ID and password for future reference.
- Update your Profile (the link My Profile on the right-hand side). Make sure affiliation, e-mail address, country, and bio statement contain correct and complete information. This information will only be used in the context of editing and publishing your paper.

- Click the New Submission link and follow the submission process outlined in [the submission guidelines](#):
 1. Confirmation of Copyright
 2. Metadata – for book reviews, please only include a short biographical statement not to exceed 50 words and your contact details.
 3. Main Text
 4. Supplementary Files – not relevant for book reviews
 5. Confirmation
